

About Your Insurance

There are two types of health insurance that will help pay for your eye care service and products. You may have both and our practice accepts both.

1. Vision Care Plans (such as VSP and Eyemed)
2. Medical Insurance (such as Blue Cross Blue Shield and Medicare)
 - Vision Care Plans only cover routine vision exams along with eyeglasses and contact lenses. Vision plans only cover a basic screening for eye disease.
 - Medical Insurance **MUST** be used if you have any eye health problems or systemic health problems that have ocular complications. Your doctor and your case history will determine if these conditions apply to you.
 - If you have both types of insurance plans it may be necessary to bill some services to one type of plan and other services to another. We will coordinate your benefits to minimize your out of pocket expense.
 - We will try and obtain advance authorization of your insurance benefits before your appointment so you may be informed of your coverage. If there are fees that are not paid by your insurance plan, you will be billed for any unpaid deductibles, co-pays, or non-covered services as allowed by the insurance contract.
